


## ALL LIT UP BOOK CLUB QUESTIONS Anomia by Jade Wallace Published by Palimpsest Press

- 3. Memory is a big theme in this book: slipping memories, things misremembered, people forgotten. What do you think the author is saying about memory?
- 4. In medicine, the word "Anomia" refers to the difficulty in spontaneously finding words during conversation or in naming tasks, and is considered a manifestation of impaired word access or representation. In sociology, anomie or anomy is a social condition defined by an uprooting or breakdown of any moral values, standards or guidance for individuals to follow. Why do you think the author chose this title?
